

March Gladness Is Coming!

March Gladness is an emphasis for contacting members, prospects, and FRAN’s (friends, relatives, associates, and neighbors) for Sunday School during the month of March. Contacts may be personal visits, phone calls, personal emails, and letters or notes. Whatever kind they are, they are contacts inviting people to Sunday School. Let’s see how many contacts we can make in March.

How to get started:

Who do you contact?

- Class members – everyone on your class roll
- Prospects – those who have visited your class or the church
- FRAN’s – friends, relatives, associates, and neighbors – Who do you know!
 - Determine your FRAN’s – write their names and contact info on a sheet of paper
 - Then contact them until you get a response – just don’t leave a message, etc.

Contact Contest:

We will be having a “contact contest” among the adult Sunday School classes. How many contacts can your adult Sunday School class make for each of the four Sundays in March. Please follow these guidelines:

- Get class members to turn in their number of contacts each Sunday
- Record the total number of personal contacts by members of your class on your SS records each Sunday during March.

To determine the “winner”:

- We will use the average Sunday School attendance for the month of February as the benchmark for each class
- We will tally the total number of contacts for the four Sundays of March for each SS class
- We will then determine the ratio – total contacts/average SS attendance for February
- The winning class will receive recognition and a prize

Make someone glad; invite them to Sunday School!

So make and record those contacts, and let’s have March Gladness at First Baptist Church during March!
