Haiti/Dominican Republic

Medical/Construction

February 11-18

We will work again with Tim Dortch of Hispaniola Mountain Ministries based in the Dominican Republic. Our team in 2011 enjoyed the accommodations of his wonderful home in Barahona, DR. This ministry team will take several directions, but the greatest focus will be upon construction of block houses just inside the Haitian border at a small settlement called Anse-a-Petri. Preselected families will join us as we construct in one week a block house for them following the devastating effect of earthquakes in the region.

1=lowest challenges/operations with best accommodations and relatively easy ministry tasks ---

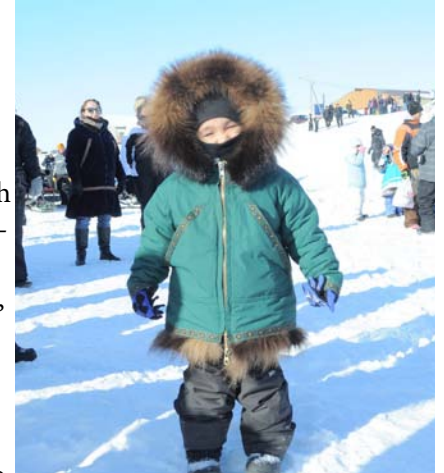
10= highest, most difficult circumstances, approaches to ministry difficult and challenges in housing)

Nome, Alaska

Service/Evangelism

March 10-18

We will be working with Brenda Crim, North American Missionary on the Iditarod! Limited spaces are available for a hearty team that is willing to go into the frozen land of Nome, Alaska. We will be involved in food service and sled-dog care. Volunteers that week will serve in over 40 different tasks to make the concluding hours of the race across Alaska possible. The trip requires two plane rides to get into the small town of Nome and the cost for travelers will be **\$1250**. This will provide food and lodging as well as ministry items and materials. Incentives will be provided for first 5 commitments. **Level 7**



Joplin, Missouri

Construction/Evangelism

April 13-20

Our city can certainly identify with Joplin, MO. They suffered a severe tornado shortly after Tuscaloosa. Our mission will be to work with the leading church in the area to put homes back together for the people of Joplin. The same kind of spirit and work that has begun to put our town back together is needed of a strong team for reconstruction in that area. Our plans are to take a church bus there and keep the cost low. The total amount travelers will be paying for a week's work there including room and board will be **\$300**. **Level 6**

San Pedro Sula, Honduras

Medical/Evangelism

May 25-June 1

Our plans for a medical trip this Spring include travel to the beautiful country of Honduras. We will be working with the outstanding organization called Salt and Light. This fine non-denominational group has many teams come to the beautiful lake just west of San Pedro Sula. Their cottages on the lake and fine food make it a favorite spot for medical teams. Within 20 minutes from the camp we can quickly get into the deep mountain villages of Honduras. Great physical needs can be met medically as well as spiritual needs through evangelism in the forms of VBS and village witnessing. **Cost \$2000. Level 6**



Poplar, Montana

Family Trip/VBS

June 18-22

Our main focus will be Vacation Bible School. Children who've completed the 3rd grade are welcomed to participate with at least one parent. It will be a great Family trip working with the Sioux Indians on the reservation. We worked here at the Blue Church two years ago. Pastor Vance is still leading the congregation and meeting the needs of this remote but beautiful part of Montana. We'll fly into Minot, ND then bus over to Poplar. **Cost of the trip including room and board will \$800 for first family member, \$400 for second and \$200 for third. Level 5**

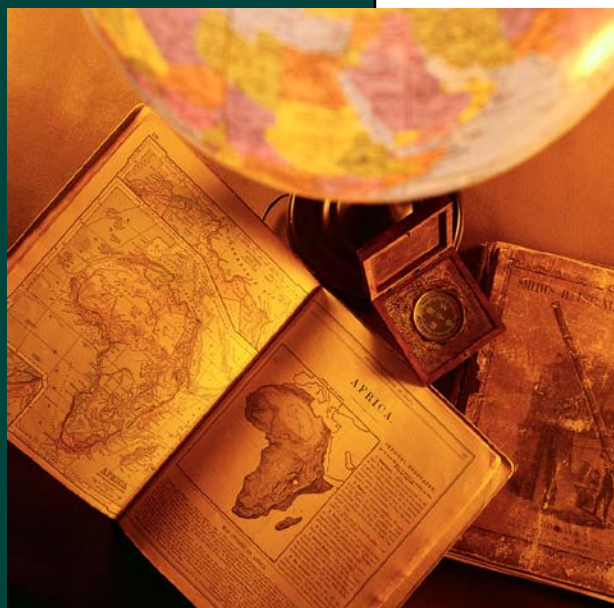


Dar es Salaam, Tanzania
