**6:00 p.m. in the Chapel**

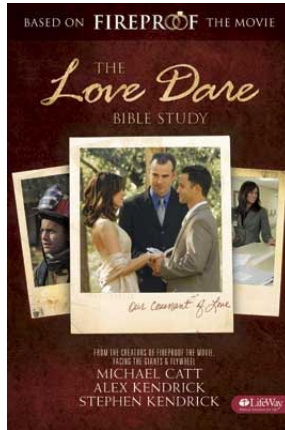
Worship led by Matt Rouse; Message by Dr. Gil McKee

### Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace University

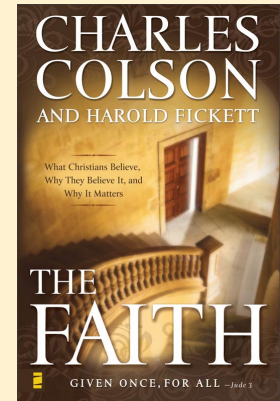
