### *The Truth Project*

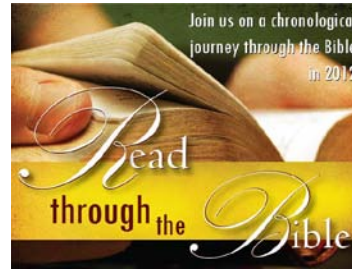
Begins Sunday, January 15

As we read through the Bible in 2012 as a church family, many of us will need encouragement and support to “stay on task.” Using the *Reader's Guide to the Bible* from the *Read the Bible for Life* program, accountability groups, such as this one, will meet weekly – when possible - throughout 2012. What a great opportunity, especially for a Sunday School class, to encourage one another and to discuss each week's reading and even Dr. McKee's Sunday morning sermon! (The *Reader's Guide* is a chronological 52-week reading plan that is divided into six reading segments with a brief commentary along with small-group discussion questions each week.) Although the accountability groups will not meet until after the New Year, the *Reader's Guide to the Bible* is available now, so that people can begin their reading on New Year's Day. The cost of the Reader's Guide is \$8.00.
