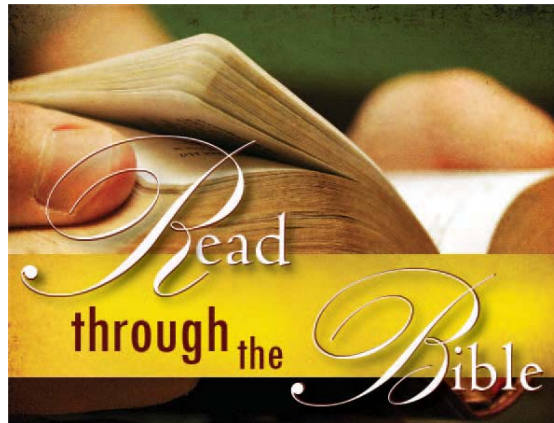


what it really means to call yourself a Christian, one who denies himself and truly follows Jesus. Cost of the “Follower’s Journal” is \$10.00.

(The Reader’s Guide is a chronological 52-week reading plan that is divided into six reading segments with a brief commentary along with small-group discussion questions each week.) Although the accountability groups will not meet until after the New Year, the *Reader’s Guide to the Bible* is available now, so that people can begin their reading on New Year’s Day. The cost of the Reader’s Guide is \$8.00.

Mid-Week Devotion

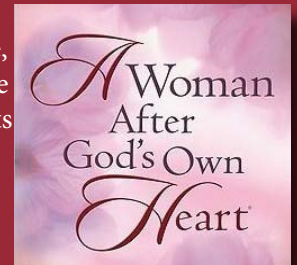
