- Look for a special request from teachers about Halloween parties on the 31st.



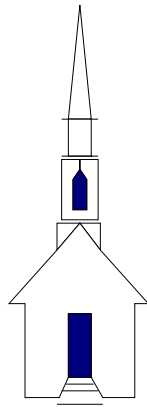
