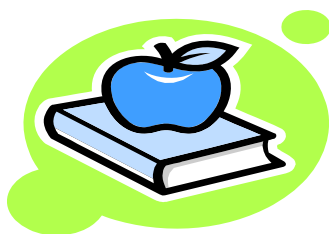

- Friday, June 14th, will be our Father's Day celebration.

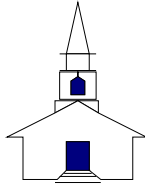

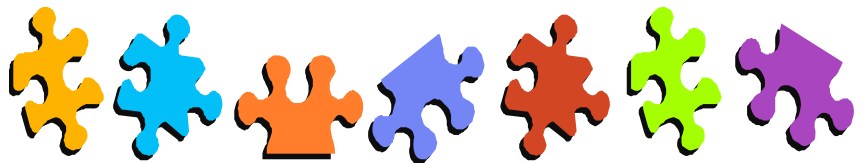
